Dr. Levin,

I apologize, I was hoping Brock would have a chance to better explain this quote today. This is only one method to replace the PCs that you have (and as you can see it is the more expensive one at the moment).

This quote is for an additional server that will be setup as a virtual desktop host. We will install separate virtual machines for each user and provide the 3 thin clients for the direct PC replacements (Linda, Erin, Venica). These thin clients will each connect to the users machine which resides on the server. This allows us to take advantage of the server computing power.

We would then create two more virtual machines (for you and Jessica) to use and retire the existing "virtual server" (TERM). By doing this, we make sure every person has their own machine and can access them remotely from any computer at any time. All of their data will be available to them but stay locally on the server.

The services piece of this project involves setting up the new server, 5 - Windows 7 virtual machines, migrating everyone's data into the new environment, setting up remote access for users you specify (at the least, you and Jessica), creating a new virtual server for ACT!, training, and post support.

I understand this is quite an investment. Alternatively I had asked Brock to prepare a quote for just the replacement desktops in the case you would like to see that as well. That would be leaving everything as is and simply migrating data to the new desktops.

Please let us know if you have any questions. I'll let Brock comment on how long it would take to receive the equipment.
